Eighth-graders and their parents (or guardians) should discuss the options for 9th grade and complete this printed form together, **so students can use these printed forms as guides when they enter their ninth-grade applications on CPS-networked computers at their current schools.** The other side of this printed form looks the same as what students will see on the computers at schools. The parent (or guardian) should sign this printed form so the teacher assisting with the application entry can verify that the information entered by the student was agreed upon with the parent.

Instructions For CPS’ 8th-Graders Entering Applications Electronically:

- **Enter your student identification number.** This number can be found on your latest report card. If you can’t find your student number, ask your teacher for help.
- **Click on “Submit.”** Your personal information (birth date, home address and phone number, etc.) will be displayed. **Please make sure this information is correct.** If it is not correct, go to the school office to give them correct information before continuing with your application.
- **Enter “Yes” or “No”** about whether your information is correct.
- If you entered “Yes,” **enter your top choice for ninth grade, then enter your second, third, fourth and fifth choices in order (in case top choice is filled)** in the area labeled “School Name.” Enter your choices in preferred order. The high school that is your first choice should be entered on the Choice 1 line. Your second choice goes on the Choice 2 line, and so on.
- **Enter the program that you wish to attend at each school you pick** in the area labeled “Program.” (On this printed form, see the list below for the school and program combinations.) Note: You may enter a school/program combination only once. You may enter another program at the same school as another choice.
- Do you have a sibling attending your Choice 1 school? **Enter “Yes” or “No.”** If you have a sibling attending your Choice 1 school, you will be given priority to enter that same school (if you meet that school’s eligibility requirements). A sibling is a student who lives at your same address and is attending your Choice 1 school in grades 9, 10 or 11. (A sibling in grade 12 is expected to graduate and not attend that school next year, so no priority is granted.) Sibling priority applies only to your Choice 1 school. **If “Yes,” enter the sibling’s name in the proper area.**
- When all choices have been entered, **click on “Continue.”** On the next screen, check the information you have entered. If it all is correct, **click “Submit.”** Your application will be saved, and a receipt will be printed for you.
